ORDER CORRECTING SCRIVENER'S ERROR

The Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") hereby corrects a scrivener's error in the Final Order Modifying Conditions of Certification ("Final Order") issued on October 8, 1996. The Final Order's revised Condition I.A.2.c included the following formula for determining the sulfur dioxide (SO₂) emission limitation when coals with a sulfur content greater than 3.63 percent are co-fired with petroleum coke:

That formula in the Final Order is hereby corrected to read as follows:
