Ash Benefication Operation St. Johns River Power Park

Dear Mr. Chansler:

The Department has become aware that a recently constructed operation, an ash benefication process located at the St. Johns River Power Park, was not included in the FINAL Title V Air Operation Permit Renewal, clerked on December 29, 2003, and effective January 1, 2004. The original air construction PSD review (also, assumed for Power Plant Siting) for the new activity was done such that the new operation was permitted as a part of the St. Johns River Power Park facility and, therefore, it is a part of the St. Johns River Power Park's/Northside Generating Station's Title V facility. Because these emissions units were not included in the renewal, it is the Department's obligation to open the Title V Air Operation Permit (Permit) for cause to install these emissions units and their applicable requirements in the Permit in accordance with Rules 62-4.080(1) and 62-213.430(4), F.A.C., and 40 CFR 70.7(f). It is our understanding that only the No. 1 line has been constructed, started operation in May of 2003, and compliance tested in September of 2003; and, it is projected that construction of the 2<sup>nd</sup> line is to begin this summer. In accordance with Rule 62-213.420(1)(a)2., F.A.C., the application for incorporation of the affected emissions units, specifically the emissions units of the No. 1 line, should have occurred in about November of 2003. In order to incorporate these emissions units and their applicable requirements in the Permit, please provide the appropriate pages of the application form pursuant to Rule 62-210.900(1), F.A.C. In addition, please be reminded that there is a Department form available to you to establish an Alternate Responsible Official for the new operation at Rule 62-213.900(8), F.A.C.
