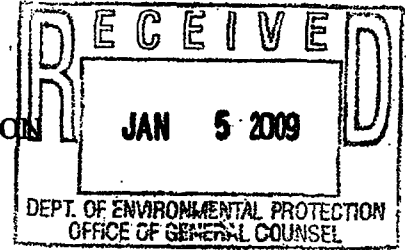

REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

By and through undersigned counsel, JEA hereby requests, pursuant to Florida Administrative Code Rule 62-110.106(4), an extension of time to and including March 6, 2009, in which to file a Petition for Administrative Proceedings in the above-styled matter. As good cause for granting this request, JEA states the following:

1. On or about December 22, 2008, JEA received from the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) a Revised Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination, a Revised Proposed Draft Air Permit, and a Revised Written Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit (Permit No. PSD-FL-401, 0310561-001-AC) for the Greenland Energy Center located in Duval County, Florida.
2. The Revised Draft Permit and the Revised Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination contain several provisions that warrant clarification or correction.
3. Representatives of JEA have corresponded and will continue to correspond with staff of the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation in an effort to resolve all issues. Additional time is needed to continue these discussions and to reach a resolution of the pending issues.
4. This request is filed simply as a protective measure to avoid waiver of JEA's right to challenge certain conditions contained in the Revised Draft Air Permit and Revised Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination. Grant of this request will not prejudice either party, but


will further their mutual interest and likely avoid the need to file a petition and proceed to a formal administrative hearing.

5. JEA representatives have attempted to discuss this extension request with Ronni Moore with the Department's Office of General Counsel and the Department.

WHEREFORE, JEA respectfully requests that the time for filing a Petition for Administrative Proceedings with regard to the above-referenced Revised Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination, Revised Proposed Draft Air Permit, and Revised Written Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit (Permit No. PSD-FL-401, 0310561-001-AC) be formally extended to and including March 6, 2009. If the Department denies this request, JEA requests the opportunity to file a Petition for Administrative Proceedings within 10 days of such denial.


