SECOND REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

By and through undersigned counsel, JEA hereby requests, pursuant to Florida Administrative Code Rule 62-110.106(4), an extension of time to and including November 7, 2008, in which to file a Petition for Administrative Proceedings in the above-styled matter. As good cause for granting this request, JEA states the following:

1. On or about August 20, 2008, JEA received from the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) a Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination, a Proposed Draft Permit, and a Written Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit (Permit No. PSD-FL-401, 0310561-001-AC) for the Greenland Energy Center located in Duval County, Florida.
2. The draft permit contains several provisions that warrant clarification or correction.
3. JEA requested an extension of time within which to file a petition for administrative petition on September 2, 2008, and the Department granted the extension through October 10, 2008, by order issued on September 10, 2008. Representatives of JEA have corresponded and will continue to correspond with staff of the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation in an effort to resolve all issues. Additional time is needed to continue these discussions and to reach a resolution of the pending issues.
4. This request is filed simply as a protective measure to avoid waiver of JEA's right to challenge certain conditions contained in the Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit. Grant of this


request will not prejudice either party, but will further their mutual interest and likely avoid the need to file a petition and proceed to a formal administrative hearing.

5. Counsel for JEA discussed this extension request with Ronni Moore with the Department's Office of General Counsel, and the Department has no objection to an extension through November 7, 2008.

WHEREFORE, JEA respectfully requests that the time for filing a Petition for Administrative Proceedings with regard to the above-referenced Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination, Proposed Draft Permit, and Written Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit (Permit No. PSD-FL-401, 0310561-001-AC) be formally extended to and including November 7, 2008. If the Department denies this request, JEA requests the opportunity to file a Petition for Administrative Proceedings within 10 days of such denial.






