As required by 40 CFR 63.8070(b) of the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) regulations, Subpart HHHHH (Miscellaneous Coating Manufacturing), Armstrong World Industries Pensacola Facility hereby submits the initial notification of potential applicability under this Subpart. This notification will specifically address all applicable initial notification requirements of 40 CFR 63, Subpart A, as referenced under Subpart HHHHH.

- iv. **Brief description of size of source, nature, design and method of operation, emission points and regulated HAPs:** The Armstrong World Industries Inc. Pensacola Facility manufactures acoustical ceiling tile. Paint for the tiles is mixed on-site. The types of emission points associated with the paint mixing process include storage tanks for paint and raw materials, process vessels for mixing, and fugitive component emissions. It has not yet been determined if any of these emission points are subject to a specific standard. The hazardous air pollutants emitted may include Triethylamine, Formaldehyde, Vinyl chloride, Diethylene glycol, Acrylamide, Ethyl acrylate, Diethanolamine.
- v. **Statement of area or major source:** this facility is a major source of hazardous air pollutants.

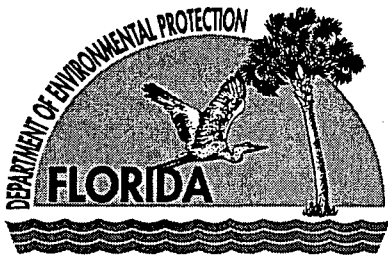
