## PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE V AIR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT

The Department of Environmental Protection (permitting authority) gives notice of its intent to issue an air construction permit to Champion International Corporation - Pensacola Mill for a modification to the No. 6 Power Boiler and the operation of the mill located at 375 Muscogee Road, Escambia County. The applicant's name and address are: Champion International Corporation, 375 Muscogee Road, Cantonment, Florida 32533. A Best Available Control Technology was not required pursuant to Rule 62-212.400, (PSD).

Muscogee Road, Cantonment, Florida 32533. A Best Available Control Technology was not required pursuant to Rule 62-212.400, F.A.C., and 40 CFR 52.21, Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD).

An air quality impact analysis was not required because there were no significant increases in any pollutant emissions. Emissions from the facility will not consume PSD increment and will not significantly contribute to or cause a violation of any state or federal ambient air quality standards.

The Department will issue the Final permit with the attached conditions unless a response receive in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

The permitting authority will accept written comments concerning the proposed permit issuance action for a period of 14 (fourteen) days from the date of publication of this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Construction Permit. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station #5505, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400. Any written comments filiad shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in the proposed agency action, the permitting authority shall revise the proposed permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.

The Department will issue the permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S., before the deadline for filing a petition. The proceedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

Mediation is not available in this proceeding.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.549, and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.) The petition final period of the of the public notice or within fourteen days of publication of the of the public notice o

(a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known;
(b) The name, address and telephone number of the petitioner; name, address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how petitioner's substantial rights will be affected by the agency determination;
(c) A statement of how and when the activities

of now petitioner's substantial rights will be affected by the agency determination;

(c) A statement of how and when the petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action;

(d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so state;

(e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle petitioner to relief; and

(f) A demand for relief.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the permitting authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.31, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the permitting authority's final actin may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the permitting authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.
