PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE AIR PERMIT

Florida Department of Environmental Protection

Applicant: The applicant for this project is Gulf Power Company. The applicant's responsible official and mailing address are: Mr. Michael Burroughs, Vice-President, Power Generation, Gulf Power Company, Crist Electric Generating Plant, One Energy Place, Pensacola, Florida 32520.

Facility Location: The applicant operates the existing Crist Electric Generating Plant, which is located in Escambia County on Pate Road, off of 10 Mile Road on Governors Bay North of Pensacola, Florida 32514.

Project: The applicant applied on May 19, 2014 to the Department for a Title V air operation permit renewal for above referenced facility. This is a renewal of Title V air operation permit No. 0330045-025-AV. The existing facility consists of four predominantly coal-fired fossil fuel steam generators (boilers) and two fly ash silos. Boilers 4 and 5 w Acid Rain Phase I substitution Units. Boilers 6 and 7 w Acid Rain Phase I Units. All four boilers are subject to Acid Rain Phase II and CAIR requirements. In addition, the boilers are subject to 40 CFR 63, Subpart UUUUU, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) and Oil-Fired Electric Utility Steam Generating Units which also referred to as the Mercury and Air Toxics Standards (MATS). Pulverized coal is the primary fuel for boilers 4, 6 and 7. Natural gas, fuel oil and on-specification used oil are used as supplemental fuels in all four of the Boilers. The facility also has engines which are regulated under 40 CFR 109, Subpart IIII, Standards of Performance for Stationary Compression Ignition Internal Combustion Engines and 40 CFR 63, Subpart ZZZZ, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) for Stationary Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engines (RICE) adopted in Rules 62-204.800(8)(b)80 and 62-204.800(11)(b)82 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), respectively.

Permitting Authority: Applications for Title V air operation permits for facilities that contain Acid Rain units are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 40 Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-210, 62-2 and 62-214, of F.A.C. The proposed project is not exempt from air permitting requirements and a Title V air operation permit is required to operate the facility. The Office of Permitting and Compliance in the Division of Air Resource Management is the Permitting Authority responsible for making permit determination for this project. The Permitting Authority's physical address is: 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida. The Permitting Authority's mailing address is: 2600 Blair Stone Road, MS #5505, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400. The Permitting Authority's telephone number is (850) 717-9000.

Project File: A complete project file is available for public inspection during the normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (except legal holidays), at the address indicated above for the Permitting Authority. The complete project file includes the draft permit, the Statement of Basis, the application, and the information submitted by the applicant, exclusive of confidential records under Section 403.111, F.S. Interested persons may view the draft permit by visiting the following website: <http://www.dep.state.fl.us/air/emission/apds/default.asp> and entering the permit number shown above. Interested persons may contact the Permitting Authority's project review engineer for additional information at the address or telephone number listed above.

Notice of Intent to Issue Permit: The Permitting Authority gives notice of its intent to issue a renewed Title V air operation permit to the applicant for the project described above. The applicant has provided reasonable assurance that continued operation of the existing equipment will not adversely impact air quality and that the project will comply with all appropriate provisions of Chapters 62-4, 62-204, 62-210, 62-212, 62-213, 62-214, 62-296 and 62-297, F.A.C. The Permitting Authority will issue a proposed permit and subsequent final permit in accordance with the conditions of the draft permit unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or a significant change of terms or conditions.

Comments: The Permitting Authority will accept written comments concerning the draft Title V air operation permit for a period of 30 days from the date of publication of the Public Notice. Written comments must be received by the close of business (5:00 p.m.), on or before the end of this 30-day period by the Permitting Authority at the above address. As part of his or her comments, any person may also request that the Permitting Authority hold a public meeting on the permitting action. If the Permitting Authority determines there is sufficient interest for a public meeting, it will publish notice of the time, date, and location in the Florida Administrative Register (FAR). If a public meeting is requested within the 30-day comment period and conducted by the Permitting Authority, any oral and written comments received during the public meeting will also be considered by the Permitting Authority. If timely received written comments or comments received at a public meeting result in a significant change to the draft permit, the Permitting Authority will
