**White Springs Agricultural Chemicals, Inc**  
**Request for Further Extension of Time**

Pursuant to Rule 62-110.106(4), Florida Administrative Code, White Springs Agricultural Chemicals, Inc., ("WHITE SPRINGS") hereby requests the Department further enlarge the time to initiate administrative proceedings pursuant to Section 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes, with regard to the Department's "Intent to Issue a Title V Air Operation Permit Renewal", Draft Permit No. 0470002-48-AV ("draft permit") for the Suwannee River/Swift Creek Complex. WHITE SPRINGS received the referenced permitting action on March 8, 2005. On good cause shown, the Department previously granted WHITE SPRINGS an enlargement of time through and including July 25, 2006. Good cause for granting a further 60-day enlargement of time, through and including **September 25, 2006**, is as follows:

1. A revised draft permit is expected to be issued by July 28, 2006. The revised draft permit is expected to address WHITE SPRINGS' issues of concern with the draft permit.

2. Staff and consultants for WHITE SPRINGS will need sufficient opportunity to review the revised draft permit to ensure that it is acceptable, as well as to make arrangements for publication of notice thereof, and forward the appropriate documentation to the Department. WHITE SPRINGS thus requests a further extension of 60 days to protect its rights in the meantime.

3. An enlargement of time would not cause prejudice, as the Department is still in the process of preparing the revised draft permit.

4. Undersigned counsel has conferred with counsel for the Department concerning this request for extension, but Department counsel was unable to confirm whether the Department would agree to the extension request prior to the filing of this request.

For the foregoing reasons, it is requested that the deadline for filing a petition initiating administrative proceedings in regard to the referenced agency action be extended through **September 25, 2006**.
