On October 12, 1995, the Seminole Board of Trustees approved a new three-year purchase power agreement with Florida Power Corporation. Under the terms of the agreement, Seminole and Florida Power Corporation have agreed to re-structure 150 MW of an existing long-term agreement, at the same time expanding Seminole's purchases by an additional 455 MW from January 1999 through the end of 2001. This agreement will allow Seminole to delay the planned January 1999 in-service date of a 440 MW combined cycle unit at the Hardee County site (Hardee Unit #3).

At this time, it does not appear to be necessary to revise or amend either the Power Plant Siting Act certification or any of the other permits issued to the Hardee Unit #3 Project to accommodate this delay. We will be contacting you in the very near future related to any specific follow up which may be required. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter and look forward to your continued support on this Project.
