Dear Mr. Delvecchio:

On July 3, 2003, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP, or “the Department”) received your application for a non-Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) air construction permit and a Title V revision to authorize the use of whole tire derived fuel (WTDF) as a supplemental fuel in the No. 2 Kiln System at the Brooksville Portland cement manufacturing facility. As you indicated on the second page of the application form, you desire concurrent processing of the air construction permit issuance and the Title V air operation permit revision. To facilitate concurrent processing, you must waive the processing time requirements of the air construction permit to accommodate the processing time frames of the Title V air operation permit. [Rule 62-213.405(1)(c), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)]

Please submit a letter waiving the processing time requirements for the air construction permit, using language substantially similar to that found on page 2 of the “Application for Air Permit – Long Form” or within Rule 62-213.405(1)(c), F.A.C.
