 The Department of Environmental Regulation (DER) hereby gives notice of its intent to issue to Florida Crushed Stone Company (FCS) a construction permit, No. AC-222225, and an amendment to the Federal permit, No. PSD-91-012, authorizing continuous utilization of materials in the facility's crushed stone plant. The Department in issuing this permit to issue for a proposed crushed stone plant in the proposed location in Pasco, Hernando, Citrus, and Manatee counties, Florida (see map attached to the permit). The applicant, FCS, has filed a permit application with the Department on November 1, 1992. The Department is reviewing the application and will issue a decision on the permit within 90 days of the date of the application. The permit will authorize the applicant to operate the plant in accordance with the conditions set forth in the permit.
