Rinher Material, Brookville Cement Company agrees to a minor air construction permit amendment to incorporate a permit condition that will restrict cement plant operating conditions in a manner that will assure compliance with the D/F emissions limits of the NESHAP for Portland cement plants.

Specifically Rinher agrees to the following.

For Kils No. 1 to operate during times the power plant is not operating and during times the power plant is starting up the raw mill down time shall not exceed 10 consecutive hours.

For purposes of this condition, power plant start up is defined as the period beginning with the initiation of Fuel Firing (either oil or coal) and continuing for 72 consecutive hours.


The conditions herein do not apply during the start up of the cement plant.

The conditions herein may be amended if Richer provides the Department with other assurance, acceptable to the Department, that the D/F emission limits will be complied with.
