Request for Extension of Permit

I am writing this letter on behalf of CEMEX, Inc. to request an extension of the referenced permit. The permit is set to expire on July 6, 2008; and more time is needed to finish construction and conduct testing to demonstrate compliance with the permit. Facility personnel report that construction is expected to be completed by the end of July 2008. Approximately 6 additional months will be necessary to complete initial compliance testing and associated reporting.

We are respectfully requesting that the permit expiration date be extended by 1 year, to July 6, 2009.

This request is generally consistent with the permit, specifically Section II. Facility-Wide Specific Conditions, Specific Condition No. 7. This condition states:

Expiration: This air construction permit shall expire on (3 years from date of final issuance). The permittee, for good cause, may request that this construction and PSD permit be extended. Such a request shall be submitted to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation prior to 60 days before the expiration of the permit.

Although this request falls short of the 60 day prior notice referenced in the permit; it is in accordance with Rule 62-4.080(3), F.A.C. which states in pertinent part:

A permittee may request that a permit be extended as a modification of the permit. Such a request must be submitted to the Department in writing before the expiration of the permit. Upon timely submittal of a request for extension, unless the permit automatically expires by statute or rule, the permit will remain in effect until final agency action is taken on the request. For construction permits, an extension shall be granted if the applicant can demonstrate reasonable assurances that, upon completion, the extended permit will comply with the standards and conditions required by applicable regulation.
