Dear Christy,

To follow up on our conversation, Cemex Construction Materials Florida, LLC is requesting additional time to conduct trials of the tirefluff material as approved in permit 0530021-035-AC (modification of 0530021-031-AC). This request is made as the kiln has been down over 45 percent of the time since issuance of the original permit (0530021-031-AC) in May, 2011. Economic conditions have and continue to force kiln shut downs. While Cemex strives to plan downtime well in advance, Cemex is subject volatile industry market conditions that can quickly change the planning of these shutdowns. Furthermore, the supply of tirefluff has been limited and sporadic. These factors have caused long-term normal operations data during trial testing to be limited.

Cemex is requesting to have an additional 120 days to conduct the tirefluff trials as specified in Section 3, condition 3.k. of the permit.
