As we discussed during our telephone conversation of Monday, April 2, 2012 and following discussions with Al Linero and other staff members on Friday, March 30, 2012, CEMEX requests to withdraw the joint AC-AV application for the above captioned FDEP projects submitted to the Department on or about February 23, 2012. The purpose for withdrawing the application is to amend the AC portion of the application to include additional projects related to the separation of the CEMEX Kiln No. 1 system and the CPL Power Plant.

The AC application will be amended to incorporate the projects discussed with your staff and the application will be re-submitted as a stand-alone AC application. Once the AC permit has been finalized, and all of the conditions necessary to re-permit Kiln No. 1, Kiln No. 2 and associated emission units at the CEMEX Brooksville South Cement Plant as a stand-alone cementplant have been agreed to, an application willbe re-submitted for the Title V Permit.
