The Florida Department of Environmental Regulation, under authority delegated by U. S. Environmental Protection Agency Region IV has reviewed your application to construct the reference source under the provisions of Prevention of Significant Deterioration Regulations (40 CFR 52.21) and has made a preliminary determination of approval with conditions. Please find enclosed two copies of the Preliminary Determination.

A public notice will be run on February 25, 1981 in a local newspaper, <u>Sebring News</u>. A copy of the summary and your application will be open to public review and comment for a period of 30 days. The public can also request a public hearing to review and discuss specific issues. At the end of this period, FDER will evaluate the comments received and make a final determination regarding the proposed construction.
