The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed permit issuance action for a period of 14 (four-teen) days from the date of sublication of this Public Notice of Intent to Issue PSD Permit Modification. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station # 2505, Talliahassee, FL 23399-2400. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in the proposed opency action, the Department shall revise the proposed permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice. Public Notice.

The department will issue the permit with the attached con-ditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S., before the deadline for filling a peti-tion. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below. Mediation is not available in this proceeding. A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set_forth_below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department of 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tailahassee, Florida, 32399-3000. Petitions filed by the permit applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under section 120.60(3) of the Florido Statutes must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public no tice or within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of Intent, whichever occurs first. Under section 120.60(3), however, any person who asked the De-partment for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of re-ceipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall moil a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filling. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrafive determination (hear ing) under sections 120.569 and 170.57 F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. 'Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the fil-ing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205 of the Florida Administrative Code. A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following in-formation: (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or Identification number, if known; (b) The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner, the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner's repre sentative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an expla-nation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be substantial interests will be affected by the agency defer-mination; (c) A statement of how and when petitioner re-ceived notice of the agency action or proposed action; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate; (e) A concise state-ment of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require
