PSD Class I significant impact levels are exceeded for SO2 in the PSD Class I Chassahowitzka National Wilderness Area located 86 km to the northwest, therefore a Class I PSD increment analysis for SO2 was conducted. Based on the required analyses, the Department has reasonable assurance that the proposed project will not cause or significantly contribute to a violation of any or PSD increment in the Class I area. A person wnose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Common-wealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35. Tallahassee, Florida, 32399-3000. Petitions filed by the permit applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the opublic notice or within fourteen days of publication of the public notice of intent, which ever occurs first. Under section 120.50(3), however, any person who asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition to the applicant at the address indicate of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing.
