Dear Mr. Fancy:

In accordance with Specific Condition 10 of the subject permit, Gardinier would request a six month extension to the construction permit.

This extension is requested because of delays in construction of the No. 2 Sulfur Storage Tank, which is slated for completion at/or around the end of September 1990. Additionally, upon completion of construction, a performance test will have to be scheduled in conjunction with the arrival of a sulfur bearing ship. As the arrival date for a sulfur ship is somewhat volatile, the performance test can not be scheduled with absolute certainty for any given date.

Gardinier anticipates that this extension will allow adequate time for completion of both the construction of the #2 sulfur tank and performance testing of the system.

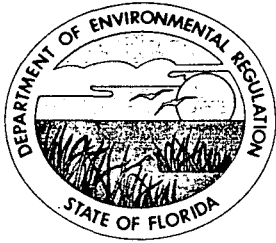

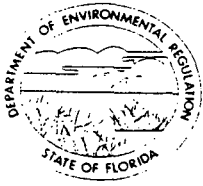

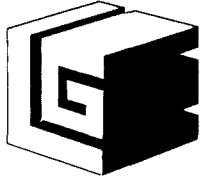

Dear Mr. Baig:

In accordance with Specific Condition 10 of the subject permit, Gardiner requests a six-month extension to the construction permit.

As you are aware, this project experienced some delays in construction. In addition, scheduling of the required performance tests has been found to be very difficult. The arrival schedules for sulfur delivery vessels is very volatile and the infrequent deliveries commonly occur at night or on weekends. The permit requires that vents for all three of the sulfur storage tanks be tested while unloading. This will require a minimum of two shipments to accomplish. In order to provide the Environmental Protection Commission of Hillsborough County an opportunity to witness the performance tests, and to avoid the necessity of submitting an operating permit application prior to completion of these tests, a six-month extension is requested.

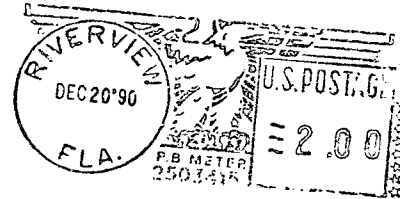
