If there are none, ne petition must so indicate; (e) A concise tatement of the ultimate facts alleged, including tatement of the unimate lacts alleged, including warrant sworn to and subscribed by me, this $\underline{5}$ day eversal or modification of the agency's proposed if ction; (f) A statement of the specific rules or tatutes the petitioner contends require reversal r modification of the agency's proposed action ncluding an explanation of how the alleged facts elate to the specific rules or statutes; and, (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Permitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.
