The purpose of this email is to notify the Florida Department of Environment Protection (FDEP) Tampa Electric Company (TEC) would like to withdraw the application for Air Construction Permit 0570039-032-AC (Ammonia Slip Testing). Tampa Electric believes the compliance test deadline for the ammonia slip as referenced in Air Construction Permit 0570039-020-AV, Specific Condition A.20 of May 31, 2007 is inconsistent with the Consent Decree and all other Title-V compliance testing deadlines, and thus the deadline should be September 30, 2007. Tampa Electric appreciates FDEP willingness to work with TEC who has completed ammonia slip compliance stack testing according to the schedule as indicated in its Title-V permit (as per suggestion of the FDEP).
