

REQUEST FOR SECOND EXTENSION OF  
TIME TO PETITION FOR HEARING

Tampa Electric Company ("TEC"), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby requests that an order be entered further extending the time to petition for an administrative hearing on draft Title V Permit No. 0570039-002-AV to March 2, 1998, and as grounds therefor states:

1. TEC representatives received from the Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") draft Title V Permit No. 0570039-002-AV on October 7, 1997. The draft permit is for the Big Bend generating station located in Hillsborough County, Florida. The certificate of service for the draft Title V permit is dated October 3, 1997. The Department has entered an order extending the time for filing a petition for administrative hearing on the draft permit until January 31, 1998.

2. The draft initial Title V Operation Permit appended to the Intent to Issue contains several items that have raised issues that require a resolution prior to TEC accepting the permit.

3. TEC representatives have discussed the matter with appropriate Department staff in order to amicably resolve the issues of concern, and discussions are continuing. A meeting between TEC and Department representatives is tentatively scheduled for early February. Additional time is needed for changes resulting from this meeting to be incorporated into the permit.

4. TEC representatives have discussed an extension of time with Department staff, and Department staff did not object to an extension of time until March 2, 1998.

5. Counsel for TEC has attempted to contact Douglas Beason of the Department's Office of General Counsel, but was unable to reach him prior to filing this request for second extension of time.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company respectfully requests that an order be entered extending the time to petition for an administrative hearing on draft Title V Permit No. 0570039-002-AV to, and including, March 2, 1998.
