Per Condition 4 of the Big Bend Station PM CEM Testing at Elevated Grain Loadings Authorization, which was issued by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) on December 8, 2003, Tampa Electric Company (TEC) is required to submit to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation a written report consistent with the level of detail provided in the first three stack test events within 60 days upon completion of the protocol. 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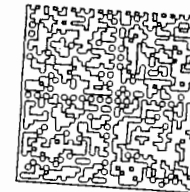
