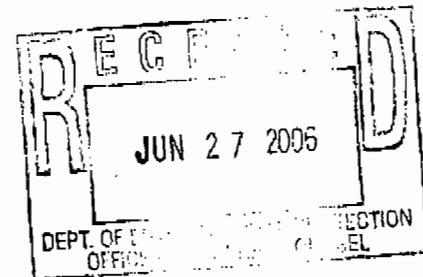

Dear Ms. Crandall:

By letter dated April 24, 2006, and received by Tampa Electric Company (TEC) on April 27, 2006, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) announced its intent to issue an air construction permit for the Fly Ash Carbon Burn-Out (CBO) Process at Big Bend Station located in Hillsborough County, Florida.

By letter dated May 11, 2006, TEC requested that the time for TEC to petition for a formal administrative hearing be extended by an additional 45 days from the deadline set forth in the Intent to Issue Air Construction Permit pursuant to Rule 62-110.106(4), Florida Administrative Code. This extension from FDEP was granted and expires on June 27, 2006. TEC requests that the time for TEC to petition for a formal administrative hearing be extended by an additional 6 months from June 27, 2006 in order to resolve contractual issues prior to finalization of the permit. TEC believes that this time will be sufficient to resolve the issues without the necessity of pursuing a formal administrative hearing.



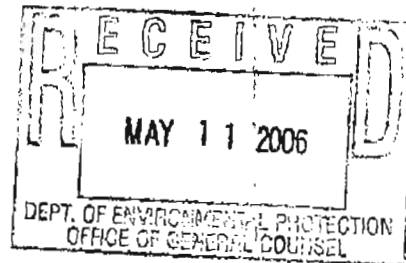
