SUBJECT: Authorization - Tampa Electric Company

On March 31, 1992, the EPC/HC received TECO's request to amend Permit A029-160258. The permit was to be amended to include a pugmill that was installed at the F.J. Gannon Station Fly Ash Silo No. 1 (DER authorization letter dated September 10, 1991).

The amendment request along with the C.O.C.O.C., compliance test results and fees were returned because the pugmill failed the 5% V.E. standard (highest 6 minute average was 6.9%). The source is a material handling operation and subject to the 5% opacity standard in Rule 17-2.650(2)(c)11.b., F.A.C. Specific Condition No. 2 of Permit A029-160258 also has a 5% visible emissions limitation.

Attached is a letter of authorization to extend the time to retest the pugmill and resubmit the appropriate information and fees.
