We have found a typographical error on page three of our letter to Mr. L. G. Kerner dated May 3, 1973. This letter was submitted into the record by John C. Bottcher, attorney for the Florida Department of Pollution Control, with the recommendation that the increment of progress dates for the subject project, namely for the conversion of Gannon Station Units 1 through 4 from coal fuel to low sulfur oil fuel, be accepted.

As the fifth increment of progress date is shown to be April 1974, where it should read April 1975, we respectfully request that the compliance schedule which is recommended to the Board for adoption reflect this change. Since the April 1975 date for final compliance is still within the statutory deadline for compliance of July 1, 1975, and as

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construction is not anticipated to be completed until October 1974 with a period of equipment shakedown required before final compliance can be assured, we trust that there will be no problem in correcting this error.

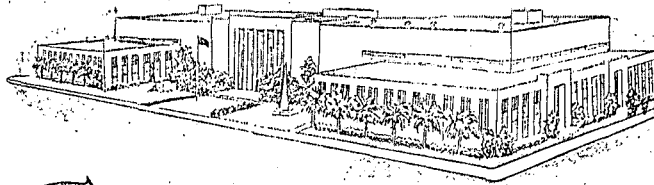
