Subject: PSD Applicability - Gulf Coast Recycling - Refining Kettles

To confirm our conversation today, it appears that EPCHC can issue the requested construction permit for the installation of new refining kettles provided the following conditions are added to the permit:

1. That the kettle installations will be evaluated in the BACT determination that will be issued when a PSD application is submitted for construction of a new blast furnace. (From all indications, the baghouse that is being installed with this modification will meet BACT requirements).

2. That the three existing kettles will be shut down permanently upon startup of the new kettles.
