SUBJ: Municipal Waste Combustor Operator Training Waiver

Dear Mr. Hoag:

Thank you for your letter, dated February 27, 2001, requesting a waiver of the municipal waste combustor (MWC) operator training requirements contained in 40 C.F.R. part 60, subpart Cb, section 60.39b(c)(4)(iii)(B). Under these provisions of the federal regulation, the owner or operator of an affected MWC facility may request that the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Administrator waive the MWC operator training requirement specified in §60.54b(d) for chief facility operators, shift supervisors, and control room operators who have obtained provisional certification from the American Society for Mechanical Engineers (ASME) on or before the date of State Plan approval.

The Hillsborough County Resource Recovery Facility is subject to the State of Florida Plan for existing large MWC units, which was published in the Federal Register on November 13, 1997, approved into 40 C.F.R. Part 62, Subpart K (62 FR 60785). According to the information submitted to EPA, Mr. Jody Howard received his ASME provisional certification as a MWC shift supervisor on November 18, 1996, and Mr. Lowel Roman received his ASME provisional certification as a MWC control room operator on September 8, 1992. On the basis of these/ certification dates and the approval date of the Florida State Plan and in accordance with §60.39b(c)(4)(iii)(B), EPA waives the MWC operator training requirements of §60.54b(d) for Mr. Jody Howard and Mr. Lowel Roman at the Hillsborough County Resource Recovery Facility.




Dear Mr. Davis,
