

REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

Pursuant to Section 120.569 and Section 120.57, Fla. Stat., Petitioner, Covanta Lake, Inc., files this Request for Extension of Time to File Petition for Administrative Proceeding and states:

- 1. Petitioner, Covanta Lake, Inc. (hereafter "Covanta"), has applied for a modification of its Air Construction/PSD permit and issuance of a Title V Operation permit (hereafter the "Permits") from Respondent, Florida Department of Environmental Protection (hereafter the "Department").
- 2. On July 2, 2001, Covanta received notice from the Department that it intended to issue the Permits, together with draft permit language.
- 3. Covanta has not had the opportunity to completely review the language of the draft Permits to determine whether it is necessary to file a petition for an administrative proceeding challenging the Permits.

4. Covanta has contacted Bruce Mitchell of the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation who agreed that an extension of time to file a petition for a thirty day period is appropriate.

Accordingly, Covanta requests that the Department grant an extension of time to and until August 10, 2001, to file a petition for administrative proceeding.
