The existing facility consists of 12 simple-cycle combustion turbines, designated as Units 3 through 14; 6 combined-cycle combustion turbines, designated as Units 2A through 2F; and two simple-cycle combustion turbine peaking units, designated as Units 3A and 3B, by the Florida Power & Light Company.
