The application requested that the specific conditions of construction permit authorized the installation of inlet foggers at the compressor inlet of the twelves simple cycle combustion turbines and established limitations on NOx and the hours of operation. Initial compliance testing was completed on November 30, 1999.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition, for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.559 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.). The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mall Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 (Telephone, 850/488-9730; Fax: 850/487-4938). Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice, under Section

120.60(3), F.S.; must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of the notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the permitting authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the dato of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The fallure of any person to file a petition within the applicable time period shall constitute a walver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filling of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the permitting authority's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if

agency's rine of identification number, if known;
(b) The name, address and telephone number of the petitioner; name address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how petitioner's substantial rights will be affected by the agency determination;
(c) A statement of how and when the petitioner received notice of the agency action oproposed action;
(d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so state;
(e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle petitioner to relief; and
(f) A demand for relief.

A petition that does not dispute the materi-

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the permitting authority's action is based shall state that no such facts arm in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above as required by Ruie 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filling of a petition means that the permitting authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the permitting authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above. Mediation is not available for this proceeding.


