The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) gives notice of 11 intent to Batte a PSD Permit for Arvali B. Hopkins Generating Station, located west of Tallahassee, Leon County. The permit allows for the Installation of two combission full binds; operating in simple cycle mode and for 5840 hours per year each. The LM6000 Sprint CT's are intended to be operated with 0.05% sulfur distillate oil for 4000 hours per year and pledine natural gas for the remaining 1840 hours. This is an existing facility, which currently combists hatural gas, distillate oil and residual fuel oil. A Determination of Best Available Control Technology (BACT) was required. The applicants mailing address is: 2802 Jackson Bluff Road, Tellahassee FL 32301.

The applicant has indicated that the installation of 2 combustion furbines (CT's), rated at approximately 50 MW each is required in order to accommodate projected peak load demands; an ancillary emergency generator is also requested. Based upon the equipment selected, anticipated fuel usage and plantied operation, the City of Tallahassee has proposed to install selective datalytic reduction systems on each CT (for the reduction of NOX emissions) as well as oxidation catalysts for the reduction of carbon monoxide [CO]. Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC's), formaldehyde and Non-Methane/Non-Ethane emission, As a result, the regulated emission limit for NOX will be 5 ppmvd © 15% O2. Based upon the Department's review, the applicant's propeds meets the Department's BACT requirements. A summary of the emission totals is included below:

The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed permit issuance action for a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of publication of this Public Notice of Intent to Issue PSD Permit. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station \$5505. Tallabassee, FL 32399-2400. Any written comments filled shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in the proposed agency action, the Department shall revise the proposed permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.

The Department will issue the permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to sections 120.509 and 120.57 F.S., before the deadline for filing a petition. The proceedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

This PSD permitting action is being coordinated with a certification under the Power Plant Siting Act (Sections 403.501-510, F.S.). If a petition for an administrative hearing on the Department's Intent to Issue is filed by a substantially affected person, that hearing shall be consolidated with the certification hearing, as provided under Section 103.507(3)

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may perition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Moil Station #35, Tallohassee, Florida, 32399-3000. Petitions filed by the permit applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent. Petitions libed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under section 120.60(3), however, any person who asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mall a ropy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (bearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the fitting of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.203 of the Florida Administrative Code:


