The Arvah B. Hopkins Generating Station is an electric production facility consisting of two steam generating units (Unit 1 produces a nominal 68 MW and Unit 2 produces a nominal 240 MW) and two simple cycle gas turbines (GT1 produces a nominal 16.3 MW and GT2 produces a nominal 26.8 MW).

This form is submitted to the agency as the Part 1 Notification of 40 CFR 63 for the two simple cycle combustion turbines located at the facility. These two units are designated as Emission Unit -002 and Emission Unit -003 in the Title V permit (Permit No. 0730003-001-AV).
