Final National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP):

Reinforced Plastic Composites Production; and Engine Test Cells/Stands

Dear Mr. Pita:

You indicated, in the 112(j) notifications that you submitted last year, that the two Monterey Boats facilities in Williston may be subject to the NESHAP (40 CFR 63 Subpart WWWW) for Reinforced Plastic Composites Production, and the NESHAP (40 CFR 63 Subpart PPPPP) for Engine Test Cells/Stands. You may be interested in knowing that on April 21, 2003, the USEPA published the final NESHAP for Reinforced Plastic Composites Production in the Federal Register; and on May 27, 2003, the USEPA published the final NESHAP for Engine Test Cells/Stands.

If you are interested in reading the final Subpart WWWW standards, the NESHAP may be accessed through the USEPA website http://www.epa.gov/ttn/atw/rpc/rpcpg.html. In particular, you might be interested in reading Section 63.5787 "What if I also manufacture fiberglass boats or boat parts?" If you are interested in reading the final Subpart PPPPP standards, the NESHAP may be accessed through the USEPA website http://www.epa.gov/ttn/atw/engtest/engtestpg.html. "Existing" affected sources must be in compliance with Subpart WWWW standards by April 21, 2006. For the purposes of Subpart WWWW, "existing" affected sources include, but are not limited to, affected sources that commenced construction on or before August 2, 2001. For the purposes of Subpart PPPPP, "existing" affected sources are sources that commenced construction on or before May 14, 2002. "Existing" affected sources do not have to meet the requirements of Subpart PPPPP. Only "new" or "reconstructed" affected sources will have to meet the requirements of Subpart PPPPP.

Since you also indicated in your 112(j) notification that your facility may be subject to the proposed 40 CFR 63 NESHAP Subpart PPPP, Surface Coating of Plastic Parts and Products, you may be required to submit a 112(j) MACT Title V permit revision application by October 30, 2003 unless Subpart PPPP is a final regulation by then. As you were previously informed, Subpart PPPP was **proposed** on February 3, 2003. If you have reviewed the applicability of the proposed NESHAP, and have decided that neither it nor any other proposed NESHAP applies to your facility, then 112(j) no longer applies to your facility.
