This letter is submitted pursuant to the NESHAP notification requirements for boat manufacturers (effective date of rule: August 22, 2001), for:

Monterey Boats – Williston Downtown Plant  
635 N. Main Street, Williston, Levy County, Florida 32696.

Fiberglass boats are manufactured using open mold operations resulting in emissions of styrene and methyl methacrylate from the use of production and tooling resins and gel coats. The carpet and fabric operations result in emissions of toluene and xylene. There are no closed molding or aluminum boat operations. This is a major source with allowable HAP emissions of over two hundred tons.
