



mir revision is being issued for the purpose of incorporating the terms and conditions of air construction permit No. 0770010-005-AC for the Overlay Process (EU 013). Three administrative corrections (0770010-004-AV, 0770010-006-AV and 0770010-008-AV) also are incorporated into this revision. This revision also incorporates the provisions of 40 CFR part 63, subpart DDDD, NE-SHAP: Plywood and Composite Wood Panels (PCWP).

The permitting authority will issue the Air Construction Permit and the PROPOSED Title V Air Operation Permit Revision and subsequent FINAL Title V Air Operation Permit Revision, in accordance with the conditions of the Draft Air Construction Permit and the DRAFT Title V Air Operation Permit Revision unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

The permitting authority will accept written comments concerning the proposed Draft Air Construction Permit issuance action for a period of 14 days from the date of publication of this Public Notice. Written comments should be provided to the permitting authority at the address below. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in this Draft Air Construction Permit, the permitting authority shall issue a Revised Draft Air Construction Permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.

The permitting authority will accept written comments concerning the DRAFT Title V Air Operation Permit Revision for a period of 30 days from the date of publication of this Public Notice. Written comments must be post-marked and all facsimile comments must be received by the close of business (5:00 pm), on or before the end of this 30-day period, by the permitting authority at the address below or by facsimile. As part of his or her comments, any person may also request that the permitting authority hold a public meeting on this permitting action. If the permitting authority determines there is sufficient interest for a public meeting, it will publish notice of the time, date, and location on the Department's official web site for notices at [http://tra6.dep.state.fl.us/onw](http://http://tra6.dep.state.fl.us/onw) and in a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected by the permitting action. For additional information, contact the permitting authority at the above address or phone number. If written comments or comments received at a public meeting result in a significant change to the DRAFT Title V Air Operation Permit Revision, the permitting authority shall re-

the permitting authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within 14 days of receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above; at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the applicable time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

All petitions filed under these rules shall contain:

- (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known;
- (b) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner; the name, address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the agency determination;
- (c) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the agency decision;
- (d) A statement of disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate;
- (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action;
- (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action, including an explanation of how the alleged facts relate to the specific rules or statutes; and,
- (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the permitting authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action the

demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment period or unless the grounds for such objection arose after the comment period. Filing of a petition with the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62-213, F.A.C. Petitions filed with the Administrator of EPA must meet the requirements of 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(2) and must be filed with the Administrator of the EPA at U.S. EPA, 401 M Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20460.

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (permitting authority) gives notice of its intent to issue an Air Construction Permit and a Title V Air Operation

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Permit No. 0770010-003-AV. The applicant's name and address are: Mr. Johnnie Temples, Plant Manager, Georgia-Pacific Wood Products LLC, Post Office Box 322, Hosford, Florida 32334.

This Air Construction Permit makes the following revisions to permit No. 0770010-002-AC (PSD-FL-282A): fuel consumption record keeping is reduced for the flake dryers with oxidizers (EU 001), the panel press with oxidizer (EU 002) and the thermal oil heater system (EU 011); and, the averaging period for the oxidizer temperature is reduced to be consistent with the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) subpart DDDD provisions in Title 40 part 63 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

This Title V Air Operation Per-

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.). The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S., must be filed within 14 days of publication of the public notice or within 14 days of receipt of the notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked

final decision on the permitting authority on the application(s) have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation is not available for this proceeding.

In addition to the above, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 7661d(b)(2), any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within 60 days of the expiration of the Administrator's 45-day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(1), to object to issuance of any permits. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the permits that were raised with reasonable specificity during the 30-day public comment period provided in this notice, unless the petitioner
