DEP ANNOUNCES INTENT TO ISSUE AIR PERMIT RENEWAL
TO FPLs MANATEE POWER PLANT

TALLAHASSEE – The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) announces its Intent to Issue a Title V Air Operation Permit Renewal to Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) Manatee Plant. As a result of negotiations, DEP and FPL have agreed on new permit conditions which will result in lower limits for Nitrogen Oxide (NOx) emissions at the Manatee Plant. FPL will install reburn control technology, will allow use of clean natural gas at the large residual fuel oil-fired Units 1 and 2, which have been in operation since the mid-1970's. Reburn technology works by injecting fuel into a power generator's boiler in an area above the regular combustion area, creating a zone that reacts with NOx to transform it into non-ozone forming atmospheric nitrogen. It is estimated that implementation of this technology will reduce NOx emissions by approximately 40% per year thereby helping to ensure Florida will continue to meet all National Ambient Air Quality Standards. Both NOx and visible emissions are continuously monitored, and NOx emission data is available to the public on the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) acid rain website located at: http://www.epa.gov/airmarkets/emissions/prelimarp/03q2/032\_fl.txt.
