Title V Air Operation Permit Renewal Request for Additional Information

Dear Mr. Plotkin:

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection has reviewed your application for a renewal of the Title V Air Operation Permit for the Manatee Plant. However, we must deem your application *incomplete*, because we need further information relative to the following items:

- 1. Please provide an assessment as to the applicability of the following federal regulations with regard to the emergency generators at the plant:
 - 40 CFR 60, Subpart JJJJ—Standards of Performance for Stationary Spark Ignition Internal Combustion Engines.
 - 40 CFR 63, Subpart ZZZZ—National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Stationary Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engines.
- 2. In order to evaluate your requested change to the excess emissions provisions for Unit 3, additional information will be needed to determine whether this change to the methods of operation could result in an actual emissions increase, and to what extent. We will need historical data documenting the frequency and duration of start-up times, the excess emissions recording practices, the actual emissions recorded during startups events, the manufacturer's specifications for startup, etc. Because the Title V permit renewal that this air construction permit change request was submitted concurrently with contains an Acid Rain part that must be final and effective by January 1, 2009, it will be very difficult to adequately address the construction permit change and be able to complete the Title V and Acid Rain renewal in time to meet the January 1 deadline. Therefore, in order to ensure the successful issuance of the Acid Rain part by the January 1 deadline, it is our recommendation that the Air Construction permit revision request be separated from the Title V permit renewal request. If it is desired to keep the Title V permit and the Air Construction permit requests tied together, then the Acid Rain portion of the permit will need to be issued separately from the Title V permit under a stand-alone Public Notice. Then, when the issues surrounding the excess emissions change request are resolved, the Title V permit can be issued concurrently with the Air Construction permit under a separate Public Notice. Please provide either a statement that it is agreeable to separate the Air Construction permit and issue the Title V and Acid Rain permits together or a statement that you would prefer to issue the Acid Part separately and keep the Air Construction permit and the Title V permit together.
