Re: Section 112(j) Notification

The purpose of this letter is to notify you that the Lena Road Landfill located at 3333 Lena Road, Bradenton, Florida, 34202 may be subject to the requirements of Section 112(j) of the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990. Based on the Annual Operating Report submitted for calendar year 2001, total annual HAP emissions at the landfill were estimated to be 23.6 tons. HAP emissions were estimated using emission factors from AP-42, Section 2.4. To date, there has been no site-specific testing for hazardous air pollutants at the Lena Road Landfill. We realize that emission factors from AP-42 may not be representative of actual emissions from the site, and that the facility may have actual emissions that are above or below the estimated amount.

Source Description

This is a Municipal Solid Waste Landfill with a design capacity greater than 2.5 million megagrams (MG) and potential non-methane organic compound (NMOC) emissions greater than 50 Mg per year. All wastes disposed of in Manatee County are processed at this site. There are separate staging areas for the collection of scrap tires, white goods, yard wastes, lead-acid batteries, and scrap metal. Scrap metal, yard wastes and scrap tires are recycled. Only degradable wastes are disposed of in the landfill.

Stage II and Stage III (an inactive section) of the landfill are closed and do not require a collection system.

Stage I of the landfill is still active and a landfill gas collection and control system is installed.

Exempt and insignificant activities include fugitive dust from paved and unpaved roads, application of daily cover materials, and stockpiling of cover materials.


