This letter is being submitted to satisfy the 112 (j) notification requirements of the MACT (NESHAP) regulation. The information requested by FDEP is follows:

**1. Facility name, address & description**

Automotive Rubber Hose Manufacturing plant

**2. Source category description**

Industrial, Institutional & Commercial Boilers

**3. A list of emission units belonging to the source category**

Emission Unit # 2 (EU 02), Four Natural Gas fired boilers, total capacity of 95 MM BTU/hr for all four boilers. The HAP emissions from the four boilers are expected to be minimal. (< 0.5 ton/yr)

**4. An identification of source category for which a section 112(g) MACT determination has been made**

No determinations made, as of May 14, 2002

Since the EPA has not promulgated a MACT standard for this category, the criteria for MACT applicability is not clearly known, and therefore, it is not certain at this time whether this facility will be subject to the Boiler MACT standards.

At this time, the facility is not subject to any other MACT standards, including the Miscellaneous Organic Chemical Production & Processes (MON) rule. None of the organic chemicals listed in the MON rule, are manufactured at this facility.
