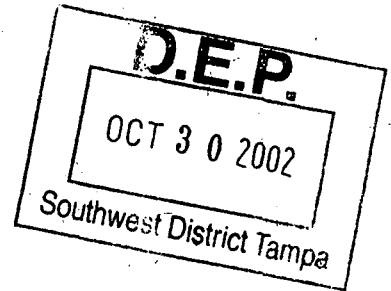

Enclosed are two copies of the air operation permit renewal application and supporting documents for the Flair Corporation (Flair) located in Ocala, Marion County, Florida. A multiple emissions unit-processing fee in the amount of \$1,750.00 is also enclosed.

Flair requests the following revisions be incorporated into the reissued air permit:

- The Small Delong Sandblast Room listed in Emission Unit (E.U.) 002 was removed from the facility in July 2002 and will not be replaced. Flair requests this source be deleted from the reissued air permit. \*
- The 1,000-gallon propane tank and Evaporator are no longer located onsite. Flair request these sources be removed from the Insignificant Activities list in the air permit.
- Wood working equipment that is used to construct shipping pallets and/or crates should be added to the exempt activities list. Since this equipment is used exclusively on wood products, Flair understands this equipment is a categorically exempt source in accordance with FAC §62-210.300(3)(a)(11) and requests the equipment be listed as an exempt source in the air permit.

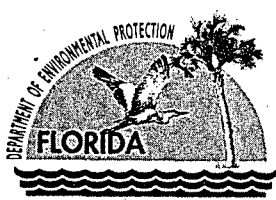

An application for a Federally Enforceable State Operation Permit (FESOP) for an existing compressed air dryer manufacturing facility was received from Flair Manufacturing on 10/03/97. This facility was recently (6/13/97) issued a construction permit (0830084-003-AC) and now wishes to obtain a FESOP to insure that the HAP limitation making it a minor non-Title V facility is federally enforceable.

The permitted facility consists of sandblasting and surface coating operations. Emissions from the sandblasters (3) are controlled by baghouse dust collectors.

Method 9 VE tests were conducted on the dust collector stacks on 08/06/97 and showed compliance with the permit limitation. VOC/HAP records were also submitted to document compliance with the VOC/HAP limits and recordkeeping requirements.

In accordance with the current requirements of Rule 62-210.300(2), F.A.C. (FESOP's), this intent to issue permit will be put out on public notice for **30** days.

I recommend that this Intent to Issue and draft FESOP permit be sent out as attached and submit it for your review and approval.

## DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE PERMIT

The Department of Environmental Protection gives notice of its intent to issue a "Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit" (FESOP), to Flair Manufacturing for the sandblasting and surface coating operations at their compressed air dryer manufacturing facility located at 4647 S.W. 40th Avenue in Ocala, Marion County DEP Permit No. 0830084-003-AE. (Applicant's mailing address: Flair Manufacturing, 4647 S.W. 40th Avenue, Ocala, FL 34474-5799, to the attention of Michael E. Golinos, Vice President Operations).

The Department will issue the permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57, of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent. A petitioner must mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes, or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it.

Any subsequent intervention will

be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with rule 28-5.207 of the Florida Administrative Code.

A petition must contain the following:

- (a) the name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Department Permit File Number, and the county in which the project is proposed;
- (b) a statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action;
- (c) a statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action;
- (d) a statement of the material facts disputed by petitioner, if any;
- (e) a statement of the facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;
- (f) a statement identifying the rules or statutes that the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and
- (g) a statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action that the petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the action or proposed action addressed in this notice of intent.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this permit. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

The application is available for public inspection during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays at 8407 Laurel Fair Circle, Tampa, Florida.

Any person may request to obtain additional information, a copy of the application (except for information entitled to confidential treatment pursuant to Section 403.111, F.S.), all relevant supporting materials, a copy of the permit draft, and all other materials available to the Department that are relevant to the permit decision. In addition any person may send written comments on the proposed permitting action. All requests and comments should be sent to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection at 3804 Coconut Palm Drive, Tampa, FL 33619 to the attention of Mr. Jerry Kissel (phone no. 813-744-6100 ext 107) referencing Permit File No. 0830084-003-AE. All comments received within 30 days of the publication of this notice will be considered in the Department's final determination.
