Thank you for your response to the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Region 4 letter dated July 14, 2011. Region 4's letter alleged that the Marion County Board of County Commissioners (Marion County) failed to comply with the Clean Air Act Title V operating permit regulations which requires all Title V facilities to certify compliance with the terms and conditions contained in their permit and to promptly report deviations from the permit requirements. Region 4's letter also offered Marion County the opportunity to discuss the alleged violation and included a Consent Agreement and Final Order as a means to resolve the matter. Based on the information provided by Marion County on July 25, 2011, Region 4 hereby rescinds the July 14, 2011, letter and considers this matter closed.
