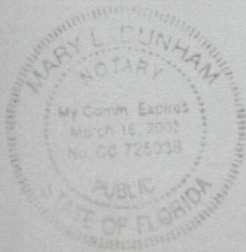

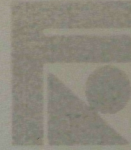

general permit for the discharge of
pollutants from a point source into
surface waters of the State of Florida.
Application No. 127208 - 11-1-98
ready for review. The permit will
be issued within 45 days of the date
of the Department's receipt of the
application. The permit will be issued
unless a timely petition for an
administrative hearing is filed per-
suasively to sections 120.025 and
120.026. The procedure for
petitioning for a hearing will be
found in the Department's rules
and regulations, which are available
to the public. The Department's
rules and regulations are available
to the public at the Department's
headquarters, 1600 Central
Expressway, Tallahassee, Florida 32309-0001,
Telephone: 904-498-6700, Fax:
904-498-4936. Petitions must be
filed within 21 (twenty-one) days
after publication of the public
notice. A petitioner must mail a
copy of the petition to the applicant
at the address indicated above at
the time of filing. The failure of a
petitioner to file a petition within the
appropriate time period shall con-
stitute a waiver of that person's
right to request an administrative
determination (hearing) under
Section 120.025 and 120.026. A
person who intervenes in the proceeding
and participate as a party in any
subsequent intervention, will be
bound by the approval of the permit-
ting officer upon the filing of a
motion in compliance with Rule 60
5.207 of the Florida Administrative
Code.
A petitioner must furnish the fol-
lowing information: The name,
address, and telephone number of
each petitioner; the applicant's
name and address, and the county
in which the project is proposed;
(A statement of facts and data
which petitioners believe support
the Department's action or pro-
posed action; a statement of
facts which petitioners believe
adversely are affected by the
Department's action or proposed
action; a statement of the mate-
rial facts disputed by petitioners;
any, let a statement of the facts
that the petitioner contends will
result from a modification of the
Department's action or proposed
action; a statement, certifying
the truth of the facts that the peti-
tioner contends will be reversed or
modification of the Department's
action or proposed action, and by
a statement of the reasons why the
petitioner seeks such reversal or
modification of the Department's
action or proposed action as
addressed in this notice of filing.
