Facility Comments

Plant generally in operation 7-5 M-F excluding some holidays. Production of ready mix concrete annually consumes approximately 5000 tons of cement, 5000 tons of blast furnace slag, 200 tons of flyash, 22000 tons of coarse aggregate, and 18000 tons of fine aggregate.
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Emissions Unit(s) Description

Site contains one split silo, capable of storing 100 tons of cement and 100 tons of blast furnace slag, and one 40 ton flyash silo. Potential emissions from both silos, the cement batcher, and the truck loading operation are controlled by a ground-mounted Vince Hagan dust collector (model VH-1094 Jet Pulse). This unit employs 0.80" Polyester Fume bags as filter media. The cementitious silos and cement batcher are connected to the dust collector via continuous piping. The truck loading area is equipped with a dust shroud, partially enclosing the loading area, which is in turn connected to the dust collection unit by ductwork. Cementitious silos are loaded at a minimum of 25 tons per hour.

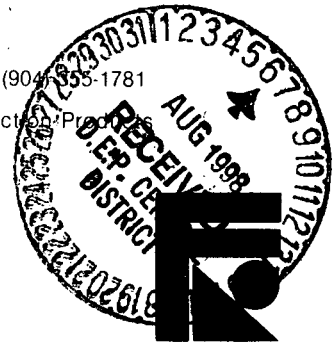

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A GENERAL PERMIT STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

The Department of Environmental Protection gives notice of its intent to issue an air general permit for the construction of a concrete batching operation to Florida Rock Industries, Inc., for the Ocala Ready Mix Concrete Plant located 3599 S. W. 74th Avenue, Ocala, Marion County. The applicant's name and address are: Florida Rock Industries, Inc., P. O. Box 1028, Gainesville, FL 32602.

The Department will issue the permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below. Mediation is not available for this action.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, telephone: 850/488-9730, fax: 850/487-4938. Petitions must be filed within 21 (twenty-one) days after publication of the public notice. A petitioner must mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Section 120.569 and 120.57 F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-5.207 of the Florida Administrative Code.

A petition must contain the following information: (a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, and the county in which the project is proposed; (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action; (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action; (d) A statement of the material facts disputed by petitioner, if any; (e) A statement of the facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; (f) A statement identifying the rules or statutes that the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action that the petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the action or proposed action addressed in this notice of intent.
