Please provide a list of the specific requirements under subpart JJ that will apply to the proposed facility. Also, provide a description of how subpart JJ requirements shall be met. Please note that 40 CFR 63.804(d) lists compliance methods, and the method selected directly affects the applicability of other requirements throughout subpart JJ.


Pursuant to Rule 62-4.055, the applicant shall have 90 days after the Department mails a timely request for additional information to submit that information to the Department. If an applicant requires more than ninety days in which to respond to a request for additional information, the applicant may notify the Department in writing of the circumstances, at which time the application shall be held in active status for one additional period of up to ninety days. Additional extensions shall be granted for good cause shown by the applicant. A showing that the applicant is making a diligent effort to obtain the requested additional information shall constitute good cause. Failure of an applicant to provide the timely requested information by the applicable deadline shall result in denial of the application.
