Your response to the Department's completeness review letter dated June 10, 1999 has been received and reviewed for completeness. The following items are needed to complete your application.

- Your response received June 23, 1999, includes a table, "Reg Specific 1. Finishing Emissions/Product Usage Summary", that demonstrates compliance with 40 CFR 63.802(b)(1) by using weighted average VHAP calculations. Since that same response indicates that using compliant finishing materials is also a compliance option, please provide a table from one of your currently operating facilities that demonstrates compliance through 40 CFR 62.804(d)(2). Also, please identify each material by class (sealers, topcoats, stains, etc...), as there are different compliance concentrations for different classes of finishing materials.
- Your response also indicates that compliance with emission limits on contact adhesives will be met by using compliant materials. provide a table from one of your existing facilities that demonstrates compliance through 40 CFR 63.804(e)(1) - no greater than 0.2 kg VHAP/kg solids.
- 3. The process description in the original application received May 25, 1999, indicates that curing ovens will be used in the finishing operations. Please provide a description of the energy source(s) for these ovens. If the ovens will be powered by fuel combustion, please include the type(s) and quantity of fuel and an estimate of emissions from the fuel combustion.

Pursuant to Rule 62-4.055, F.A.C., the applicant shall have 90 days after the Department mails a timely request for additional information to submit that information to the Department. If an applicant requires more than ninety days in which to respond to a request for additional information, the applicant may notify the Department in writing of the circumstances, at which time the application shall be held in active status for one additional period of up to 90 days. Additional extensions shall be granted for good cause shown by the applicant. A showing that the applicant is making a diligent effort to obtain the requested additional information shall constitute good cause. Failure of an applicant to provide the timely requested information by the applicable deadline shall result in denial of the application.
