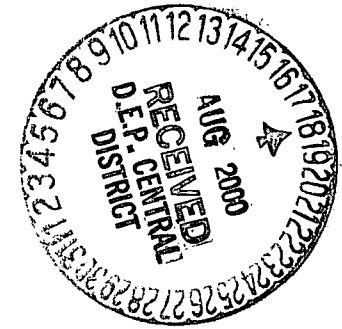

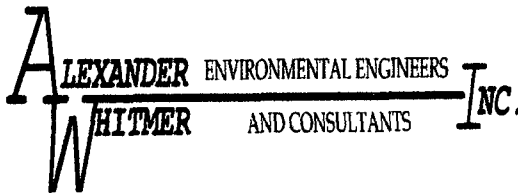

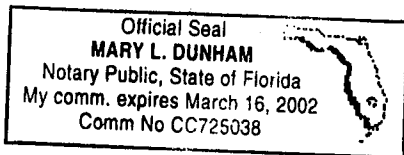

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A GENERAL PERMIT STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

The Department of Environmental protection gives notice of its intent to issue an air general permit for the construction of a concrete batching operation to American Concrete Products, L.C., for the Ocala facility located at 2355 S.W. 60th Avenue, Ocala, Marion County. The appli-

cant's name and address are: American Concrete Products, L.C., P. O. Box 620, Doctors Inlet, Florida 32030.

The Department will issue the permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below. Mediation is not available for this action.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, telephone: 850/488-9730, fax: 850/487-4938. Petitions must be filed within 21 (twenty-one) days after publication of the public notice. A petitioner must mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with rule 28-5.207 of the Florida Administrative Code.

A petition must contain the following information: (a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, and the county in which the project is proposed; (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action; (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action; (d) A statement of the material facts disputed by petitioner, if any; (e) A statement of the facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; (f) A statement identifying the rules of statutes that the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner stating precisely the action that the petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the action or proposed action addressed in this notice of intent.

This application is being processed and is available for the public inspection during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, at Florida Department of Environmental Protection, 3319 Maguire Blvd., Suite 232, Orlando, Florida 32803-3767.

<p>The facility in Ocala consists of a Stephens 837 bbl split 60/40 stationary modular low profile concrete batching plant with a radial stacker.</p> <p>The facility manufacturers redi-mix concrete which consists of various weights of type portland cement, slag (a.k.a. NewCem), natural sand and limestone rock. The products are weighed with a PSI eagle batch computer, then fed into a transit redi-mix truck. The material is mixed to the desired consistency in transit from the plant to the job location.</p> <p>Each cubic yard of concrete, on the average, consists of 200 lbs of Type I portland cement, 200 lbs of NewCem, 1300 lbs of sand and 1720 lbs of limestone rock. Production is estimated to be 6000 cubic yards a week. Operating hours will be 6:00 am to 9:00 pm Mon - Sat.</p>

Emissions Unit(s) Description

The batch plant consists of a single 837-barrel silo with a baffle that divides the silo into 2 compartments on a 60-40 split. The portland cement is housed in the larger portion (60% side) and the slag (NewCem) is housed in the smaller portion (40% side).

The air pollution and dust collection equipment consists of a dust collector on each of the split silos (Stephens Models SV265 and SV170) and a Model SV20 dust collector on the scale.

All equipment is connected to the batch panel which allows operations to engage equipment when a tanker is off loading and when a redi-mix truck is being loaded. The load rate for conventional material is approximately 25 tons/hour.
