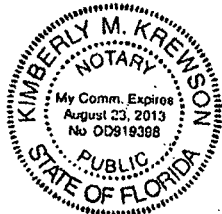

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Permitting Authority's action is based must contain the following information: (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known; (b) The name, address and telephone number of the petitioner; the name address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial rights will be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of when and how the petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed decision; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petitioner must so state; (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action including an explanation of how the alleged facts relate to the specific rules or statutes; and, (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Permitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency

action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

On 10/17/11, an application for a construction permit for modifications to the existing activated carbon production facility was received from Standard Carbon LLC. The modifications consist of refurbishment of existing Carbon Storage Silo No. 4, with emissions from silo loading to be controlled by existing baghouse PJ-4. *(See Draft permit or Technical Evaluation for more details on this project.)*

An email was sent on 10/21/11 requesting more information on how the proposed new silo will fit into the process. An email response describing the proposed use of the silo was received from the facility contact on 10/24/11, and an email response with an updated process flow diagram was received from their consultant on 11/01/11. *(Note - This process flow information request was not considered a formal RAI and it was not logged in ARMS PA, nor was the processing clock stopped/reset.)*

As discussed with Cindy Zhang-Torres, rather than have to describe the existing facility emission unit and all of the modifications authorized by Construction Permit 0810170-004-AC, (some of which have been completed and some of which are still pending), this construction permit instead just references the existing facility and EU descriptions in the current operation permit, and the descriptions of the authorized modifications in 004-AC.

The requirements for Carbon Silo No. 4 match those for the current carbons storage silos so it can easily be incorporated into the facility operation permit.

I recommend that this Intent to Issue and draft construction permit be sent out as attached and submit it for your review and approval.

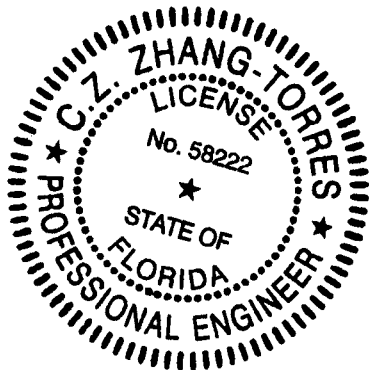

David,

Ken Given is in the field this week and asked me to respond to your questions. He will forward a new process flow as soon as he returns.

Silo 4 will be used as a blending tank to combine the 9 and 11 tank super sack material with the product stored in 8, 10 or 12, hence the separate EU. Indeed, PJ-4 is the one to be removed under the existing construction permit. Material blended in silo 4 can then be transferred to bagging for packaging, back to silos 8, 10, or 12 for storage of the blended product, or to silos 14 or 16 for bulk load-out using existing EUs. It will not receive Raymond Mill product directly.

Ken,

We received the above application for Standard Carbon LLC and I was assigned as the processor for the project. In doing a quick review of the application, I noted that the project was described only as "Refurbish Silo 4 for use for carbon storage. Use existing PJ-4 to capture emissions." There is no description of how Silo No. 4 will fit into the process and no process flow diagram was included with the application.

In order to write the permit and describe what is being authorized, I need to know how Silo No. 4 will be used. Where will the carbon going to Silo No. 4 come from and where will the carbon from Silo No. 4 go to? Will it be used like Carbon Storage Silo Nos. 8, 10 and 12 (Emission Unit (EU) No. 009), or like Carbon Storage Silo Nos. 14 and 16 (EU Nos. 010 and 014), or for some other purpose (like to store powdered activated carbon delivered in super-sacks like Fly Ash/carbon Storage Silo Nos. 9 and 11 (EU No. 002))? If possible, I also need an updated process flow diagram for the process area that will include Silo No. 4, showing how it fits into the process flow.

Also please confirm that Baghouse PJ-4 is the existing baghouse that was on EU No. 009 (Carbon Storage Silo Nos. 8, 10, and 12), but was authorized to be removed (and replaced by PJ-2) as part of recently issued construction permit 0830170-004-AC.
