## Gentlemen,

Emergency Generators have been installed at the location referenced above as part of FPL's Hurricane Hardening program. The generators were installed after the Title V Permit renewal process was submitted completed. The generators provide power to a small "safe room" constructed for operating employees to use in the event of a significant storm. Each safe room has two generators; a primary and a back up. The generators are fueled by propane stored in four 120-gallon tanks at each of the two locations.

The generators are categorically exempt from permitting as provided by Rule 62-210.300(3)(a). They are also exempt from 40 CFR Part 60 Subparts JJJJ due to their manufacture date (2005), and from ZZZZ due to their size (<500 Hp).

The next time the Title V permit is opened for renewal, both generator packages will be added as insignificant or unregulated sources.
