Re: Final National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) – Metal Can Coating

Dear Mr. Garrett:

The 112(j) notification that was submitted last year for the Sonoco Products Company, indicated that the facility would be subject to the NESHAP (40 CFR 63 Subpart KKKK) for Metal Can Coating. You may be interested in knowing that the USEPA published the **final** NESHAP regulation for this source category in the Federal Register on November 13, 2003. Therefore, 112(j) requirements no longer apply to metal can coating activities.

“Existing” affected sources must be in compliance with Subpart KKKK standards by November 13, 2006. For the purposes of Subpart KKKK, affected sources are “existing” if construction or reconstruction of the affected source commenced before January 16, 2003. For compliance dates for “new” affected sources, please refer to section 63.3483 of the standards.

The following information is submitted in response to Mr. Sheplak's letter of April 5, 2002 regarding 112 (j) notification for MACT.

- (1) Name, address (physical location) and brief description of the major source (facility).

This facility manufactures composite cans for packaging products such as frozen juice concentrate. It includes a coating line which roll-coats metal sheets which are die cut into container lids.

- (2) An identification of the relevant industry type source category (ies)

Metal can (surface coating)

- (3) A list of the emission units belonging to the relevant industry type source category (ies)

Emission unit 001 - Metal can coater #1 and drying oven #1
Emission unit 004 - Twelve end seal compound coaters

- (4) An identification of any affected sources for which a section 112 (g) MACT determination has been made.

No section 112 (g) MACT determinations have been made for these units.
